Signs of Opioid Overdose

- Can't wake the person up
- Breathing is very slow, erratic/irregular or has stopped
- Deep snoring or gurgling sounds
- Fingernails or lips are blue or purple
- Body is very limp
- Pupils are very small

Recovery Position

Put the person in recovery position if:

They are unconscious and breathing

or

You have to leave the person unattended
